

Comments and Questions From Prague Meeting

The component meta data(CMD) should be ready for use in the third quarter of 2010. Instead of using IMDI meta data, OLAC was suggested, because it resembles Dublin Core more and thus DK CLARIN meta data too. It was recommended to add our web services meta data to the Virtual Language World(VLW), thereby making the web services public to CLARIN.

The European demonstrator is well under way, but no clear end date exists. Though a workshop on content search is planned in January, it is not ending before that. Instead of having one common API for content searches, each CLARIN center can have their own.

Another general question was the state of the various centers PID's. What about DK CLARIN? Is the eSciDoc PID's sufficient?

Two, not entirely confirmed, initiatives are in the makings. The first is a home page, where the centers can exchange experiences with repository systems and infrastructures. The other is a workshop, possibly around Easter, on information sharing regarding experiences on repository systems.
